





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1. PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

1.1. The College : An Introduction

The idea of starting a college at Kovilpatti was mooted on 29th April, 1966. G. Venkataswamy Naidu College was born on 30th June, 1966 by the auspices of the G. Kuppaswamy Naidu Charity Trust for Education and Medical Relief. The regular classes commenced with the blessings of the Zamindar of Ilayarasanendal Sri K.R. Appaswamy Naidu. The College was formally inaugurated on 17th July, 1966 by Mr.M.Bakthavatsalam, The honorable Chief- Minister of Madras.

The college began with four branches of Pre-University Courses, two in Science and two in Humanities. The very next year the college was affiliated to Madurai University with B.A. (History) and B.Sc. (Mathematics) courses. Degree courses in B.Sc. Physics, Chemistry, Botany and B.Com were Started in 1972-73. The College was further upgraded into a Post Graduate Institution by starting M.Sc. (Mathematics) in 1989. The Department of Mathematics was further upgraded as the research department stream in the year 2017.

In view of the successful growth of the College, the management decided to start Career Oriented Courses in the year 1994 under Self-Financing Stream and decided to conduct all the Self-Financing Courses in a separate campus with excellent infra-structural facilities.

As a first step, B.Sc. (Computer Science) course was started under the affiliation of Manonmaniam Sundaranar

University, Tirunelveli and the other courses BBA., B.Sc. (Electronics), B.Sc. (CDF), B.Sc. (IT), B.Com., B.A. (English), B.Sc. (Statistics) and B.Com. (PA), PG Courses - M.Sc. (CS), M.Sc. (IT), M.Com and M.A. (English) Research Programme M.Phil. (Commerce) were started one after another in the subsequent years. The broad objective of research has been enhanced by upgrading the Department of commerce into a research department by starting Ph.D. programme in the year 2018. Our College has received "STAR COLLEGE" Scheme by the DBT in September 2020.

G.Venkataswamy Naidu College is an embodiment of triumph in the life of student. Adding to its greatness, NAAC has declared 'A' Grade with CGPA 3.21 out of 4. Our College has rich tradition and heritage in the enrichment of knowledge on the young minds.

Our College has gained the Autonomy status in the year 2020, as a pretty laurel in the achievement of GVN history. M.Sc., Botany, started in 2020-2021, BCA and B.Com Business Analytics added in 2021-22.

16.5. Add - on Courses and Skill oriented courses

In this knowledge blooming era, the youngsters must expertise in core subjects as well as non-major subjects. For fulfilling this aspire, Add-on Courses are conducted for all Under - Graduate students by Various Departments. Add-on Courses have been framed to enable the students :

- To cope with the emerging trends of competitive job market.
- To enrich their skills required for present scenario.
- To develop communication skills.
- To acquire knowledge for today's career.

16.6. Ragging and its consequences

- ◆ According to ACT No.7 of 1997 of the Tamilnadu Prohibition of Ragging Act, ragging in educational institutions in the State of Tamilnadu is prohibited.
- ◆ Students should not indulge in ragging / eve - teasing of fellow students. Ragging within and outside the educational institution is prohibited.
- ◆ Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates "ragging" within the educational institute, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years, and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- ◆ Any student convicted of an offence U / S 4, shall also

be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution.

- ◇ The decision of head of the educational institution shall be final for any student who has indulged in ragging under Sub-Section(1).

16.7. Rules and Regulations

All students must read the "Rules and Regulations" carefully so as to make themselves fully familiar with the rules & regulations and sincerely follow the procedures set in the college campus. Ignorance of rules can not be excused and violation will be dealt as per norms & procedures.

16.8. Dress code

- + Students should attend college in formal attire adhering to the dress code stipulated by college. Boys should come to college wearing full pants and formal shirt and it must be fully buttoned except the collar button.
- + Boys should not come to college wearing T-shirt, shirt with logo, Jeans pant, kurtha, hat or cap.
- + Boys should not come to college with coloured hair or sporting beard.
- + Girls should come to college wearing saree or Churidar with Shawl (pinned V-shape).
- + Girls should not wear half saree, modern dresses like skirt, jeans, short tops, tight fitting or transparent dress while coming to college.

16.9. Identity card

Every newly admitted student will be provided with an identity card duly attested by the Principal. They should

wear the identity card till their presence in the campus. Students will be permitted to attend the classes only if they wear the identity card. Duplicate identity card shall be obtained, if necessary from the office.

16.10. Attendance and Leave Particulars

All the students should attend the classes on all working days as mentioned in the college planner. As per the norms of the university, a student is eligible to appear for the semester examination only if he/she has secured 75% of attendance in theory and practical classes. At the time of lack of attendance the student has to pay the condonation fee provided the university approves his/her application to attend the examination. Students while taking leave should collect their leave application form from the class in-charge and then get it duly signed by the parent, class in-charge and the Principal / Director.

16.11. Campus Discipline

- (i) It is the moral responsibility of each and every student of the campus to maintain dignity, decency and decorum of the campus.
- (ii) The student must maintain his/her conduct as good, all through the stay in the Institute by abiding rules and regulations.
- (iii) Students being found a defaulter, they may be suspended from the college and also parents shall be requested to withdraw the student from the college or else the name shall be struck-off from the roll for bad conduct.
- (iv) Dedication to the work allotted, Devotion to the studies and Discipline in routine life are the three traits that a student must develop.

(v) The following are considered as Violation of Discipline / Misconduct.

- + Indulging in any sort of revolutionary or indisciplinary activities such as damaging the fitments & equipment in room / corridor / toilets / common rooms / class-rooms/laboratories.
- + Bringing cell phone to college and mere possession of cell phone inside the campus itself is wrong. In the case of defaulters, either the cell phone will be seized or they will be fined and suspended for 30 days.
- + Showing disregard to rules, regulations, notices, displayed / promulgated from time to time.
- + Failing to use proper form for college out pass.
- + Failing to keep newspaper / magazines properly after reading.
- + Failing to adhere to college timing.
- + Failing to attend special classes as per the time table.
- + Failing to pay college fee / fines / other charges within the stipulated time.
- + Failing to follow safety measure in the laboratories.

(vi) Smoking and intake of liquor are strictly prohibited. Any student found violating this will be dismissed from the college.

(vii) Boys should not enter the places reserved / allotted for the girls in the classroom, laboratory, library, seminar hall, canteen, common hall etc.

(viii) Students are advised not to bring valuable things viz., ornaments, heavy cash, electronic gadgets etc.

- (ix) Students should not bring anyone other than parents / guardians into the campus without prior permission.
- (x) Students who go out / re-enter college campus during class hours may do so only after getting permission of the Principal / Director.

16.12. Class room Discipline and Conduct

- (i) Students are expected to follow the classroom decorum.
- (ii) Students are expected to present in the classroom for the lectures before the arrival of the instructor.
- (iii) Assignments and projects should be the original work of the student. Students are expected to be punctual in all respects and they should try to submit their assignments before the last date of submission.
- (iv) Fans, lights and other electrical devices should be switched off after the lecture gets over to economize the energy. Students are expected to co-operate.
- (v) Students should be regular and punctual in attending all the classes. It is compulsory, the students should have 75% of attendance to appear for the semester examination.
- (vi) In case any student falls sick while attending classes he /she may be permitted to go home. If the student is unable to move independently, the parents / guardians of the student will be informed.
- (vii) There should not be any unusual interaction between boys and girls in the college premises. Also they should not exchange contact numbers, note, book, food etc. Violation of this will lead to expulsion of the student from the college

(viii) Celebration of birthday, applying colour powder on others, lighting crackers etc, are strictly forbidden in the college premises.

16.13. Library Discipline

- (i) The library is kept open from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on all working days.
- (ii) Students are permitted to borrow maximum of four books for UG Courses and Six books for PG Courses respectively.
- (iii) Strict silence should be maintained in the library.
- (iv) Students should not sub-lend the library books to any person.
- (v) Students should not write, underline or make any marking in the Library book or cause any damage.
- (vi) Students on receiving books should examine them and report to the librarian, if damage found there in. If they fail to do so they will be held responsible for such damage as may be detected afterwards.
- (vii) All the books borrowed must be returned on a period of 15 days from the date of issue. Books can however be renewed and provided if they are not required by any other student. For renewal, the book must be presented to the librarian for inspection.
- (viii) If the book is not returned on due date, an over - due charge of Rupee 1/- (one) per day will be collected. For Over - due charges intervening holidays will also be included.
- (ix) Loss of books shall be promptly reported to the librarian. If a book is damaged or lost, the cost of the book will be collected from the student.

- (x) Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate will be issued to the students only on the production of a "NO DUES" Certificate from the Librarian.

16.14. College Bus Discipline

- (i) The girl students travelling by college bus should always have their bus pass and college identity card with them.
- (ii) The students travelling by college bus must pay their bus fee before the date specified by the institution.
- (iii) The boarding point of every student must be clearly mentioned in the office at the time of bus fee payment and if there are changes in the boarding point it should be informed to the office before hand.
- (iv) Students should not reserve seats in the bus for their friends.
- (v) Students should maintain discipline inside the bus. In case of Indiscipline, severe action will be taken.

16.15. Vehicle rules

- (i) Students should ensure that they park their two / four wheelers in a proper systematic manner. Parking shall be done only at specified parking area as indicated by the college authorities.
- (ii) Wearing helmets and following traffic rules is a must for safety purpose.
- (iii) Students should have a valid driving license and submit Photo copy of the same in the office.
- (iv) If a student is found, driving rashly / carrying excess number of students will face disciplinary action. All students shall look themselves with pride and sense of belonging to the family of G.V.N College. The students

maintain the decorum of the college thus making themselves a good member of the team, society and prove valuable citizens of the country.

EXAMINATIONS

About our Curriculum :

Choice Based Credit System, (CBCS).

Higher education in India is going through a phase of rapid expansion, competing with national and international standards. Under the impact of liberalization and globalization a need for reforming higher education system, in - line with the need and expectations of the society, has been felt necessary. In accordance with this trend, the institution has introduced the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for the students admitted in various Programmes from the academic year 2020-21 and onwards.

Outcome Based Education

OBE Curriculum at both UG/PG levels is designed based on the approach of Outcome Based Education (OBE). The central aspect of OBE is to set measurable learning outcomes for programmes and courses and then align it with teaching and learning and assessment processes. Bloom's Taxonomy has been used as the basis for setting learning outcomes, teaching methods and students assessment.

Internal Tests :

Two tests for Continuous Assessment will be conducted on pre-determined dates that is 1st test (1 hour) commencing on the 35th day from the date of reopening, 2nd test (1 hour) on the 70th day. The Model Exam (3 hours) will be conducted after completing 85 working days.

Absentees for Internal Tests:

Appearance of CIA is mandatory to take up the ESE. However, if a student is not able to write the Internal Tests because of his/her participation in an important event related to NCC, NSS or Games/Sports representing the College/University, the student has to get the prior permission of the Principal through the proper channel and submit the same to the Office of the Controller of Examinations. Retest request should be submitted to the COE's Office within 7 days after the completion of I & II Internal test. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered for retest. There is no retest for Test III (Model Exam).

Marks for Attendance:

A student is expected to put in 75% of attendance during His/her course of study in the programme for all semesters to be eligible for appearing the ESE. To encourage a student's regularity and active participation in the classroom activities, His/her attendance shall be given marks in every course during the semester.


